

Snappy Offline Driver

On the odd occasions you have to get into a corner, gaining access with a battery drill can be tricky. This offline driver, then, serves a great purpose.

It has a ball and socket connection, lightly spring-loaded so that it pulls back straight for general work, but tilts to 15° when needed. It's certainly handy for the application shown here – hanging and adjusting wall cupboards for level using the jacking screws.

It's not designed for use in an impact driver, but a drill driver usually offers more control in the applications where this would be suitable anyway, so it's a useful addition to the toolbox for the odd occasion you need to get into a tight spot more easily.

It fits a standard 1/2in hex collet and comes with a No.2 Pozidriv bit.
