Trend Snappy Angle Screwdriver Attachment

In his driver attachment is the latest in Trend's growing Snappy range. Its rubberised body is an improvement on the old metal-body types out there, as it offers better control in tight corners. An extra handle fits either side, improving control as torque increases as you're driving screws. The standard kin hex shank will fit into any Snappy chuck, or a standard three-jaw drill chuck.

Gearing through the body links the shaft to the chuck spinning it at 90°. The tool comes with a uouble-ended Pozidriv bit which fits the standard hex shank collar. You slide a knurled sleeve on the chuck to release the bit. I tried fitting a standard 25mm long, single-ended screwdriver bit, but it was too short, dropping inside the chuck. You either need to fit a standard bit adaptor to take them, which defeats the object of its narrow accessibility profile somewhat, or you need longer 50mm bits

(Snappy range from £4.50 for three).

With the supplied bit in place the tool is pretty compact. If you've ever struggled to get a screw in or out in a cupboard or other cramped space, an angled screwdriver is invaluable. This is the one time you really need a magnetic bit chuck to hold a screw in position. Oddly, Trend did not magnetise theirs! On offer at £24.95.
